

ORDINANCE NO. 2

**Cross Connection Control Program**

The Tilden Township Board, Marquette County, by resolution adopted on February 9, 1982, hereby establishes the following cross connection control program for the Tilden Township water supply. The Township water supply operator shall conduct the program under the supervision of the Township Board and shall enforce the Tilden Township cross connection ordinance adopted April 8, 1980, and shall enforce the state cross connection control regulations, in the following manner:

1. Non-residential customers (3 in number) will be inspected for compliance within six months of this date.
2. Residential customers known or suspected to have a cross connection such as a private well or a treated hot water system (10 in number) will be inspected for compliance within one year.
3. Customers with cross connections that might allow sewage or toxic chemicals to enter the water system will be disconnected from the system until corrections are made, due to the extreme health hazards involved.
4. Customers found in violation, but without extreme hazards, will be given time, not to exceed 120 days, to make corrections and will be notified in writing of the required corrections.
5. Customers notified to make correction will be re-inspected for compliance within 150 days of the notice.
6. After compliance is established, non-residential customers with protective devices will be re-inspected annually.
7. Residential customers without cross connection problems will not be re-inspected. Those which require a protective device will be re-inspected annually.
8. Non-residential customers without protective devices will be inspected each two years to assure continued compliance.
9. All new customers will be inspected and brought into compliance before turn-on.
10. Michigan Department of Public Health approved cross connection protection devices or protective methods will be required in accord with Michigan's Cross Connection Rules Manual.
11. Appropriate records will be maintained in the Township office and will be employed for preparation of the annual report to the Michigan Department of Public Health.
