WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Households with incomes between 151-300% of the Federal Poverty Level may be eligible for Heat and Electric assistance, pending Income Verification and completion of Program Requirements.

MONTHLY INCOME LIMITS FOR MI IMPACT

Households who are over assets for State Emergency Relief may also qualify for Heat and Electric Assistance through MI Impact Funding.

WHAT IS IT?

MI Impact provides
assistance for households
who have traditionally not
been eligible for utility
assistance. This assistance
can go toward Heat, Electric,
and Water & Waste
expenses.
